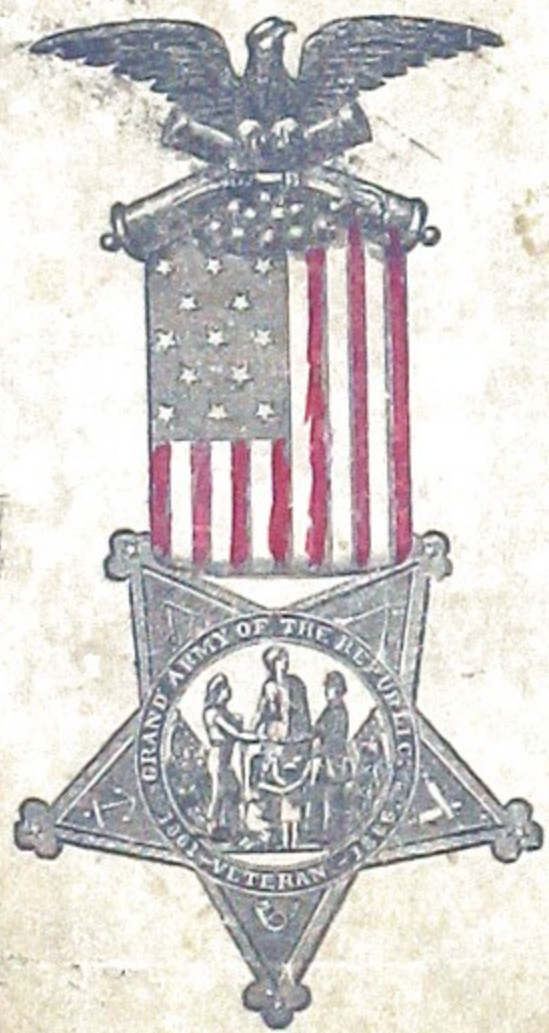

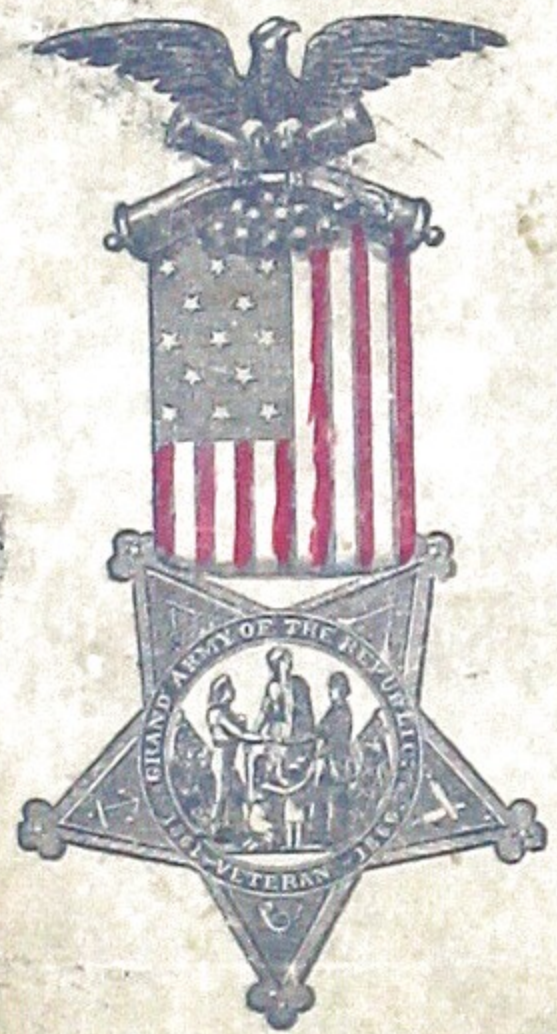

The Post was organized March 14, 1883, and named in memory of Lieut. James B. Brainerd, 6th Mich. Heavy Artillery, who died at New Orleans, La., June 3, 1864.
